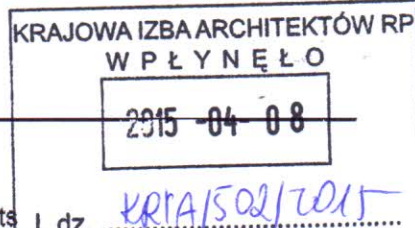

We are sorry for reacting so belatedly to your letter dated of 5th November 2014 in which you were seeking information on our legislation related to the coexistence between residential buildings and adjacent spots.

Belgium, as a Federal State, does not currently hold any national legislation setting permissible level or impact and its effects on adjacent plots. The jurisdiction or competence for such legislation fall under the Federal entities.
